

Faculty Research Fellowships

Purpose

The purpose of these research fellowships is to provide flexible funding over a 2 year period to enhance the research efforts of faculty in the Fulton College.

Eligibility

All faculty members in the college who are involved in research as part of their normal professional responsibilities are eligible to apply.

Amount of Award

Fellowships will consist of \$10,000/year for two years. Fellowship funds will be available for use as student salary, supplies and/or travel.

Selection Criteria

The primary criterion for selection is the impact that the fellowship will have on research in the college. This impact may include:

1. The impact of the fellowship funds on the research activity/success of the applicant.
2. The use of the funds to initiate new research areas of significance.
3. The use of the funds to establish new collaborative efforts, both in and out of the college.
4. The potential for the fellowship funds to be leveraged into significant external funding.
5. Etc.

Application Process

Applications consist of a 1-2 page description of how the fellowship funds will be used, including a short budget. This description should *highlight the expected impact of the funds*. Applicants should also attach their CV. Applications should be submitted to your department chair by July 6th. Department chairs will rank the proposals for their unit and submit their top two candidates to the college by July 20th.

We anticipate awarding two fellowships per year. Our plan is to continue this program as a regular part of our efforts to support research in the college, subject to the availability of funds.
